

## Creating a Podcast with iMovie

- 1) Create a New Project (File > New Project)
- 2) Add Images
  - a. Click on the camera icon (right side)
  - b. Drag pictures from the Photos section into the Project Window
  - c. Adjust duration (how long you want the image to stay on the screen) and add video effects by double clicking on the image
  - d. Make other adjustments by clicking on the blue “cog” box that appears when you cursor over the picture
  - e. (all adjustments can be made/edited later, too)
- 3) Add Narration
  - a. Click on the microphone icon (middle)
  - b. Click where you want to begin recording—countdown to start recording will start (hit space bar when done)
  - c. Make adjustments to duration, volume, fade in/out by clicking on the “cog” box (duration can be adjusted by sliding the voiceover bar left or right)
- 4) Add Text
  - a. Click on the “T” (for “titles”) icon (right side)
  - b. Drag desired title into Project Window (either between clips or directly onto a clip)
  - c. Edit text
  - d. Double click the text bar to adjust duration (which can also be done by sliding the text bar left or right) or to choose a different title design
- 5) Add Background Music
  - a. Click the music icon (right side)
  - b. Drag the sound effect or song to the Project Window to where you want it to begin
  - c. Click on the “cog” box to adjust duration, volume, fade in/out
- 6) Preview Project
  - a. Click either the left play button (for full screen) or right play button (inset screen), both under the Project Window on the left side
- 7) To convert your Project into a Podcast
  - a. Share > Export Movie > select a size, OR
  - b. Share > iTunes > select a size
